Day One

Arrive at Fairbanks International Airport

Hike through novice or expert trails, or take the rest of the day to relax back at the lodge, enjoying spectacular panoramic views of the landscape.

Head to the touch tanks for a hands-on experience with amazing, colorful creatures that inhabit Alaska's tidal zones, and observe a mysterious Giant Pacific Octopus. Then visit the aviary to meet some of the resident puffins before you take time to explore the Center on your own.
